PRESENT	You <u>live</u> in Spain.	You <u>don't live</u> in Spain.	Do you <u>live</u> in Spain?
PAST	You <u>lived</u> in Spain.	You <u>didn't live</u> in Spain.	Did you <u>live</u> in Spain?
PRESENT	He <u>lives</u> in Spain.	He <u>doesn't live</u> in Spain.	Does he <u>live</u> in Spain?
PAST	He <u>lived</u> in Spain.	He <u>didn't live</u> in Spain.	Did he <u>live</u> in Spain?

The verb only changes in affirmative sentences.

In negative sentences and questions the verb doesn't change. The base form of the infinitive is used.
